## VESSEL SAFETY CHECK—JUNE 8TH

**O**n Saturday June 8th, from 10am to 2pm, KYC will host a Vessel Safety Check (VSC) Event. Certified vessel examiners from both the US Coast Guard Auxiliary and the United States Power Squadron will perform a **free** VSC at your boat. Sailboats and power boats are both eligible and the boat does not need to be in the water. Power boats must have a charged battery connected in order to receive a VSC. There is no charge and *no consequence* if your boat doesn't pass. The goal is simply to help make boating as safe as possible for you, your family, and friends. Boats that pass will receive a certificate which may entitle you to a discount on your boat insurance.

**T**o make sure we have enough inspectors it will be helpful to know how many boats we expect to attend. **Please email me if you are interested and are likely to attend.** Also, please feel free to reach out if you have any questions.
