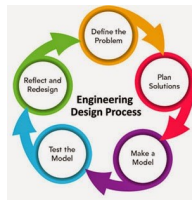

Guitar Club



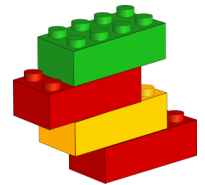
Club members will learn basic guitar chords and strumming patterns. We will play and sing 1-2 chord songs. Members do not need to bring a guitar.
