What Does Love Got to Do With It?" Do We Sound Like? What Is It? What Should It Look Lik

1 Corinthians 13:1-8 -- If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal, ² If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. 3 If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

⁴ Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. ⁵ It does not dishonor others, it is not selfseeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. ⁶ Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. ⁷ It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.
