Class Rules:

For Structured Practice Classes: horses and riders must show in legal NRCHA or AQHA equipment. All classes will be run like approved classes. Herd work-corner help and 3 minute limit. Try to limit to 3 cows worked. Reining no set pattern but will have 4 minute limit. Boxing will have 1 ½ minutes from time gate closes – 2 1/2 minutes for fence runs. Classes will be monitored. Whistle (horn) will be blown at end of time, or at end of each part of rein/box and rein/fence. Excessive training will not be allowed.

Entry forms and Cattle/Stall form: If you are coming, even if not stalling, please fill out Cattle/Stall form and submit by **January 25th, 2019, 6pm**. Once you have filled the form just hit the Green Submit arrow at top of form and form will be emailed. You will receive email confirmation for receipt of form within 24 hours. These Practice Sessions will be drawn like a regular approved NRCHA class. We will set draw times at the show once we have a better idea of how many riders/horses are coming.

Stalls/RV Spaces/Hotels:

- 1) Heated barn-Stalls \$30/night. Shavings are \$8 per bag.
- 2) \$15/day haul in fee for any horse not stalled.
- 3) RV spaces (plug in only) - \$25/night, first come, first serve.

Directions: I-25 North or South to Exit 181. East on Plum Creek Parkway, left onto Fairgrounds Road.

Banquet Directions: Golf Club at Bear Dance, 6630 Bear Dance DR. Larkspur, Co 80118, 12 minutes from Douglas County Fairgrounds, Plum creek to 25 frontage, turn left and go 5 miles turn right onto Tomah Road, immediately turn left onto bear dance Drive, and go to 2.8 miles, passing thru 1 roundabout on the way, Bear Dance Golf Club will be on the left.
