# "Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known."

That cannot be good news for anybody. We all have skeletons in our closets that we hope will stay there. But Jesus was not speaking about our faults and failures being exposed. He was talking about the responsibility that comes with our Baptism: to know and to proclaim the Good News about God's unconditional love for us by what we say and do; by our words and actions. If what we do is not reflective and consistent with what we say, others will know that we are a hypocrite. That skeleton will be out of the closet. Happily, we have the assurance of Jesus that everyone who acknowledges and imitates Him by what we say and do, He will acknowledge before His heavenly Father. Imagine standing with Jesus and hearing Him say, "Father, this is my friend, [insert your *name*], who acknowledged me before others by word and deed." And the Father says, "Come, enter into my Kingdom!" WOW!


