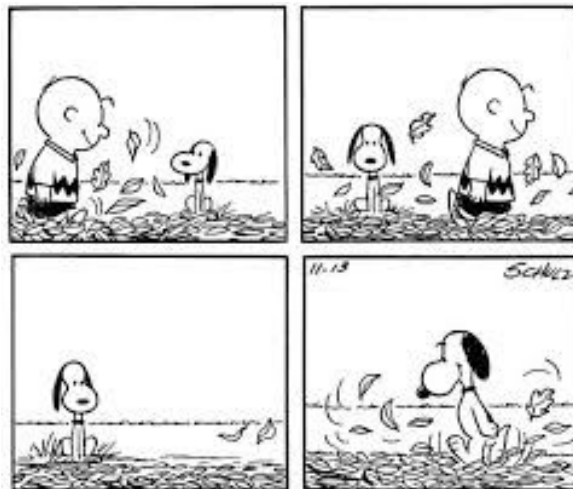
REMINDER TO USE MASKS: Please use masks at Mass for your safety and for the safety of others! Thank you for your understanding during these trying times.
