Honorary Life Membership Award and Distinguished Service Award Information:

I - New York State PTA Honorary Life Membership

New York State PTA Honorary Life Memberships are given by your local PTA/PTSA unit to individuals in recognition of their *distinguished* contributions to the welfare of children and youth.

- The recipient need not be a member of the PTA/PTSA.
- The recipient receives a pin in the presentation card as symbols of honor. (additional fee, local unit responsible for ordering)
- Life memberships are given only to individuals, not as couples or groups.
- Honorary memberships do not confer active membership status upon recipients. This can be achieved only through the payment of annual dues to a PTA unit.

II - New York State PTA Distinguished Service Award

New York State PTA Distinguished Service Awards are given by your local PTA/PTSA unit to certain individuals in recognition of their *outstanding contributions* to the welfare of children and youth or to a PTA organization.

- Recipients **must be PTA members** who have been awarded an honorary life membership. Nominees for the Distinguished Service Award need not have previously been awarded an honorary life membership at your local unit; any Shenendehowa District Council honorary life membership award may serve as a predicate.
- The award is given to PTA officers and members who had served faithfully, but it is reserved chiefly for those who have *devoted exemplary service to the maintenance and growth of the PTA*. Service to children and youth may encompass work within the community and/or school.
- Recipients of the award receive a certificate and a distinguished service pin. (additional fee, local unit responsible for ordering)
