Summer Institute – This annual professional development workshop provides educators with law related curricula that can be used in the classroom. The 2012 program covers two highly acclaimed civics curricula, *We the People* and *Street Law*. There will also be a segment on mock trials and the Honorable Scott Crichton, President of the Louisiana District Judges Association, will address attendees on *Sexting, Texting and Beyond*. The Institute will also include dialogue on *Citizens, Not Spectators* (a voting curriculum that can earn schools up to \$300 for the purchase of law related materials).

Participants – Elementary, middle and high school teachers and school administrators

Lodging – Out-of-town participants housed at the beautiful Loews Hotel located in downtown New Orleans at 300 Poydras Street.

Meals - Complimentary continental breakfasts and lunch on July 16th provided. Dinner on your own.

Parking – Loews Hotel guests will not be charged parking; if not a Loews hotel guest, parking vouchers for parking at the Loews Hotel will be furnished. For attendees that choose to not to park at the Loews Hotel, expenses are reimbursable up to \$22.00 per day upon receipt of original receipts.

Internet – Complimentary internet and Wifi in guest rooms. Wifi not available outside of hotel guest room.

Mileage – Summer Institute attendees traveling over 100 miles round trip will be eligible for a scheduled mileage reimbursement. Mileage Reimbursement Schedule:
100-200 miles - \$40, 200-300 miles - \$60, 300-400 miles - \$80, 400-500 miles - \$100, 500-600 miles - \$120

Continuing Learning Units (CLU) - Each participant will receive a certificate for earned CLU's.

We the People - Participants will be provided with one *We the People* textbook and one teacher's guide

Street Law – Participants will be provided with one *Street Law* textbook and one teacher's guide. Street Law textbooks and guides are all at the high school level.

Fees - No program fees. A registration fee of \$15.00 should accompany each application form. Checks will be returned to applicants who are not accepted in the program.

Enrollment – Space is very limited. Early submission of registration form and registration fee is highly recommended.
