1933 - 1995

Thomas S. Winięcki, 61 of Bay Port, passed away Tuesday morning, Aug. 8, at Vencor Detroit Hospital in Lincoln Park following a 13-month illness.

Mr. Winięcki was born Dec. 25, 1933 in Detroit, the son of Emily S. (Satk) Winięcki and the late Emil Danny Winięcki.

He and Patricia A. Banaszewski were united in marriage April 28, 1958 in Detroit. She survives him.

He had been a field engineer and specialist for Burroughs Corporation and later Unisys in Detroit and Saginaw for 36 years before retiring in 1989, had served in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean War, was a member of St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church in Pigeon and the West Huron Centennial Council 8042, Knights of Columbus.
