6. Motion made by Mr. DeLoach, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried concerning Horne Street for a 30 x30 easement for a pump station for the city, this will be turned over to the attorney for his legal advice.
7. Motion made by Mr. Long, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to table the Macon Lane acceptance until we have a statement from Wilford Morris and Clifton DeLoach concerning the 7 years of maintaining this road.
8. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to enter executive session for legal matters. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. DeLoach voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
9. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. DeLoach and carried to exit executive session. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Thompson voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
10. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to pay bills. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. DeLoach voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
