Please bring a copy of your last year's return along with a picture ID for the taxpayer(s) on the return.

Social Security cards or ITIN documentation for all.

Income documents – Forms W2, SSA 1099, 1099R, 1099G, 1099INT, 1099DIV and any other 1099 forms, self-employment income along with any other income documents you may have.

Brokerage statements – sale of stocks or bonds.

Healthcare – Form 1095 A, B, or C

Bank check for direct deposit/debit refund/balance due.

Receipts for all deductions to itemize.

Records of federal and state taxes paid.

Educational expenses – Form 1098-T and expense receipts.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Area Agency on Aging has home repair assistance available in Ashland, Crawford, Huron, Knox, Marion, Morrow, Richland, Seneca & Wyandot County for eligible individuals age 60 and older.

Home Repair Program 419-524-4144



The Ohio District 5 Area Agency on Aging has funding available for necessary home repairs for those age 60 and older who qualify based on their combined monthly income.

Types of home repairs include repairs for furnaces, leaking roofs, wheel chair ramps, bathroom accessibility modifications, and other necessary home repairs.

HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

A federally funded program designed to help eligible Ohioans meet the cost of home heating this winter.

Eligibility

A household whose total income is at or below 175 percent of the 2019–2020 federal poverty guidelines may be eligible. Guidelines are listed below:

Size of Household

1 person	\$ 21,857.50
2 persons	\$ 29,592.50
3 persons	\$ 37,327.50
4 persons	\$ 45,062.50
5 persons	\$ 52,797.50
6 persons	\$ 60,532.50
7 persons	\$ 68,267.50
8 persons	\$ 76,002.50

For households with more than 8 members, add \$7,735 for each individual.
