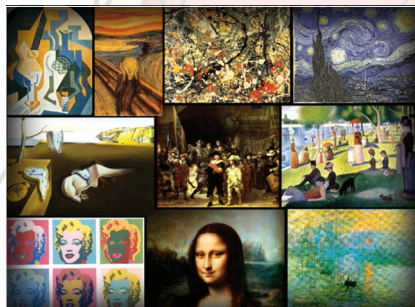
The 10 Art Exhibitions You'll be Talking About this Year
