The staff went from Firehouse subs to a tornado drill. We appreciate that it wasn't a fire

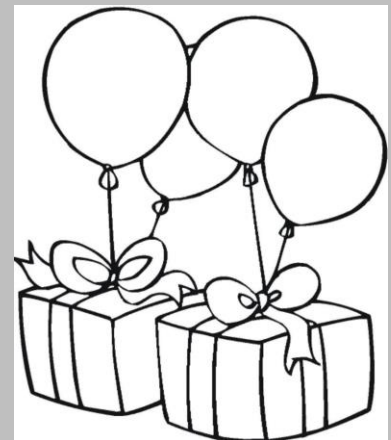
drill. The ladies and staff did a great job and new what to do during the tornado drill – we passed!

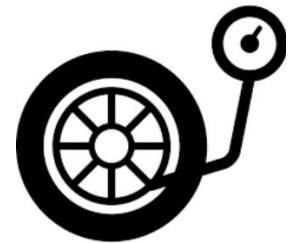


November Weather
