

Identifying occupational health flu consultations in the PharmaDoctor eTool

If CPGM pharmacist members need to record that a business has paid for flu vaccinations they can do so within the PharmaDoctor Flu eTool.

At the end of a flu consultation, on the pharmacist's consent page they'll have the option to select the type of service and need to choose 'Occupational Health service'.

So long as these steps are followed and the consultation is completed, including the record of supply, the payment code will be saved and appear on eTool consultation reports, which can be used to help calculate required reimbursement.
