## Church Music Position(s) Available:

Chancel Choir Director – choosing music, running the weekly chancel choir practice (currently meeting on Wednesdays), directing the chancel choir on Sunday morning, running the practice for and directing of the annual Christmas Cantata, and ensure special music during the Choir's two-month break in the summer (July & August). The position requires advance planning of at least one quarter out.

Pianist/Organist – accompanying the weekly chancel choir rehearsal (currently meeting on Wednesdays), accompanying the chancel choir on Sunday morning, playing the organ during the Sunday worship service as well as occasional additional services (e.g., Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, etc.), and being mindful of the possibility of playing for weddings and funerals.

Bell Choir Director – running weekly practice (currently meeting on Mondays), directing the handbell choir in the worship service at least once a month if possible and directing the handbell choir for an occasional special Sunday.
