Bloomington's water department asked that we post the following info: A pair of mature Bald Eagles has begun to rebuild their nest just west of the Hickory Creek bridge. This time of year is of critical importance to Bald Eagles with the Eagles preparing to lay their eggs in early January. We respectfully ask that all residents be vigilant in guarding against all human activity — especially snowmobiles and hiking should not occur within a 660 ft. radius of the nest. Too much disturbance will cause the eagles to abandon the nest, as was witnessed last year. Please help us to provide a safe and calm area so that we can all enjoy the Eagles for years to come.
