DESCRIPTION: This rare 63" 1962 Shakespeare X-15 was the top-of-the-line Shakespeare target bow in 1962, and sold for \$80—which translates to \$702.00 in 2021 inflation-adjusted dollars). Great looking and performing recurve in remarkable condition for its age. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. A couple of small round scratches have been touched up with a dob of closely matching ink. Someone could mistake them for small filled screw holes, but there are no holes in the bow. Decal is in fair condition. Typical yellowing of the limbs. One of the limb pictures appear s more yellow than the other, but they are the same color. It is a camera thing.

Note: They don't make AMO standard 63" strings. I recommend using a stretched-out 62" Dacron string for a higher brace height and more forgiving release. You could also use a 64" string and put several twists on it, or have someone make you a custom AMO 63" string (59" actual length).
