The Chrism Mass for the Diocese of Salt Lake City is scheduled for Thursday, April 6, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in The Cathedral of the Madeleine. At the Chrism Mass, the bishop blesses three oils- the oil of the catechumens, the oil of the infirm, and holy chrism which will be used in the administration of the sacraments throughout the diocese for the year. Bishop Oscar Solis will be the celebrant and homilist.
