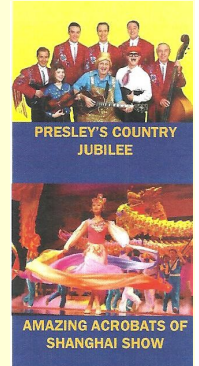

Reopening Update

EFFECTIVE JULY 6, 2020: Subject to Requirements below, the senior center will be re-opening:

1) **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY: ESSENTIAL BUSINESS i.e.: NOTARY AND MEDICARE ENROLLMENT.** Call to schedule an appointment. SHSC @ 740-385-6581.

2) **SENIOR CONGREGATE LUNCH**

- Individual must be signed up ahead of time for meals. Call HAPCAP @ 740-385-6813 to register.
- Individual must have a clean appearance including clothing to eat at the congregate site.
- Individual must arrive no earlier than 10:45 am and depart by 11:30 am
- Individual must stay in the designated area in dining room.
- Individual may not access any other part of the building.
- Individual please use the designated restroom to wash your hands prior to taking a seat.

Coronavirus Tips for Safe Laundry Care:

- Keep doing laundry!** Regular cleaning will prevent the spread of the disease as the virus can live on clothing for up to 3 days.
- The hotter the wash, the better.** Experts recommend washing items in a temperature of at least 140F (60C). Follow the clothing manufacturer's instructions and use the warmest appropriate water setting.
- Use the dryer.** Viruses do not like heat and the dryer will further prevent the spread of the disease.
- Use the right amount of soap.** Too much soap creates excess suds that cause dirt (and the virus) to remain trapped inside fabric. The right amount of soap will properly clean and rinsed from the clothing.
- Avoid shaking dirty laundry.** This will minimize possibility of dispersing the virus through the air.
- Clean and disinfect clothes hampers.** Consider placing a bag liner in your hamper that is either disposable or can be laundered.

- ◆ **3) IN AUGUST, 2020:** Pending approval from the Hocking County Health Commissioner, other services/activities will be re-opening at both buildings.
- ◆ **4) The final phase of re-opening will occur in SEPTEMBER, 2020** and will include Bingo and Choir.
- ◆ *Just a Reminder that Scenic Hills Senior Center is still serving meals & snacks to many families during the crisis. If you have any questions, employees are in the office weekdays during 8:00 am—3:00 pm.*
