Communication & language

We will be learning about rhyme by looking at objects that sound the same. We will learn the story of We're Going on a Bear Hunt, talking about 'who' is in the story. We will orally sequence the story to make a class story map.

 Spend lots of time learning rhymes and sharing them with your family.


Personal, Social & Emotional Development

This half term we will continue to make friends with others, learning their names and sharing when playing alongside others.

We will continue to talk about how we feel, remembering times when we have felt excited, scared, happy and sad.


Physical Development

We will continue with our weekly PE sessions in the hall on Mondays. We will be developing our spatial awareness playing lots of stop and go games, making sure we do not bump into anyone.

Literacy

This half term we will be listening for the initial sounds in our names and developing our awareness of rhyming words. When sharing stories we will think about 'who' is in the story and 'what' happened.

Mathematical Development

This half term we will continue to practise counting objects to 10, making sure we touch each object as we carefully count it. We are beginning to recognise numerals to 10. We will be learning to recognise and name 2D shapes.

We will continue to visit the woodlands each week, looking at the features of our environment and how they are beginning to change. Our sessions will follow the children's interests and fascinations.
