



FACT SHEET – VISITOR EXPECTATIONS

ALL visitations will be outdoors, weather permitting

A visitation area on the first floor has been set up – there is no visitation in the resident rooms/units

ALL visitors are screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, including temperature check, screening questions/assessment. Visitation will be refused if the individual(s) exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms or does not pass the screening questions. A rapid test will be offered/done on the date of the visit as part of the screening

Visitors must wear a face mask or covering that covers the nose & mouth at all times when on the premises of the nursing home & maintain social distance from other visitors, staff and residents.

Beginning August 1, 2021, visitation is permitted Sunday – Friday 1:15 PM to 7 PM with no appointment necessary for FULLY VACCINATED RESIDENTS ONLY. The resident may choose to not socially distance and/or touch their visitors – masks must be worn.

Visitors must limit their interaction to only the resident they are visiting and not visit multiple residents at a time.

Visitors for fully vaccinated residents will be screened in the lobby.

Staff members will be assigned to assist with transitioning of residents, monitoring of visitation as well as cleaning & disinfecting areas.

Visitation for residents who are not fully vaccinated will continued to be scheduled. Please contact Connie Leone at Ext. 307 to make an appointment. Visitors will continue to be screened in the separate visiting area.

Visitation is limited to two (2) persons daily per resident due to space limitations & continued requirement for social distancing between groups of visitors.

Visitors will be asked to use hand-sanitizer when they arrive and during their visit.

Social distancing, as marked in the visiting area, must be maintained at all times.

Food & beverages may not be consumed during the visit as this would require mask removal.

Compassionate visits will continue to be coordinated through the Social Workers.

If any visitor tests positive or is quarantined due to COVID exposure in the 14 days following visitation, the facility must be notified immediately.
