### **Current programs and events:**

-Picture day will be this Saturday (9/5) for Micro Mini soccer. Instead of their normal 9 AM kick offs, games will start at 9:30 AM.

-On Monday, the open gyms for the boys and girls high school basketball began. They will continue Mondays and Wednesday nights up until basketball season starts.

-A possible fitness boot camp led by Bill Ewe was cancelled for the fall season. There is talks to revisit the camp in the future.

-Both Middle School field hockey and tennis programs are ongoing after school.

-At Alcyon, the disc golf course is complete with all 18 holes and signage around the course. The course will host the South Jersey Open on Saturday October 19. Before the tournament, a ribbon cutting ceremony will take place to officially open the course. All commission members are invited to attend.

### **Upcoming programs and events:**

-All various basketball signups will take place in two weeks, either on the 16th or 17th of October (although no official date has been decided). In addition, we are looking for instructors for the 1st and 2nd grade "Young Gunners" in-house programs. Also, open gym basketball will start next Thursday (9/10) for 3rd-8th graders to give the children a place to play with freedom to do what they want.

-The commission is looking into renovations for the tennis courts. Talks have been ongoing, including about resurfacing the courts. The price range right now appears to be from \$50-75,000. Along those same lines, Parks and Recreation has also been asked about helping with putting a new scoreboard in the High School gym. Ideally, the scoreboard will work for both basketball and wrestling.
