

## Athletic Directs Meeting Minutes

1. Opening Prayer
2. Reading of the minutes from the December League Meeting
3. Financial Report
  - a. Income – As of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018, \$49,308.32 in account
  - b. Expenditures – Different bills are being submitted, so account will recede.
4. Coaches meeting for Spring sports – Hopefully questions were answered and schedule changes will be as is or at a minimum after the coaches meetings today.
5. Commissioners Report
  - a. Basketball-Varsity boys and girls – great games, especially in Tournament of Champions- Our Lady of Lourdes won the girls and St. Rose won the boys. Primary Division – Happening right now. JV boys and JV girls – Happening now. Remember all primary basketball questions or concerns go to Commissioner Danny.
  - b. Cheerleading – ADs, Coaches, and Principals were emailed; commissioner has now received all music for the competitions. March 29<sup>th</sup>, competition location was just cancelled. As soon as commissioner Odalys has confirmation on new location, another email will be sent.
  - c. Soccer – February 23<sup>rd</sup> will be girls' finals and semi-finals, and boys on March 1<sup>st</sup> at Belen. Times will be forthcoming. Please let your parents know there is a charge at the gate. Remember there will be Track & Field field events going on, but they will not interfere with Soccer.
  - d. JV & Varsity Baseball and Softball – JV going on now, Varsity will start in April.
  - e. Softball Tournament – teams entered: First Friday in April. There are 4 boys and 4 girls teams (8 total). Boys: Belen, Immaculate, Holy Rosary, St. Theresa and Girls: Immaculate, Holy Rosary, St. Louis, St. Theresa. It's a 1PM Dismissal, coaches meeting at 1:45PM, first game starts at 2PM. The 4 back fields at Tamiami.
  - f. Track & Field – Started this Saturday at Holy Rosary. Top overall 6 teams will qualify for the JV and Varsity Championship. Only 3 individuals per event.
  - g. Golf Tournament – Mauricio reported that everything is waiting for final approval from ACC. Working on 3 different Wednesday's (1 in March, 1 in April, and 1 in May). Clinics will be held on the 1<sup>st</sup> tee @ Costa del Sol. Competitive kids will play 9 holes, the open kids will play until finished.
  - h. Flag Football – Will be starting up in March, Paul went over all the schedules. There are no kick offs. Follow the rules that are in the Standing Rules of the Constitution.
6. End of the Year Coaches Dinner – Our new Hall of Fame inductee this year will be Diane Kunkel. We will be having Casino night theme. The Dinner is filling up pretty fast.

7. Sportsman & Sportswoman Forms – Please turn in and make it available for your coaches. Please be sure to submit the person's name and their school.
8. All Conference Medallion Presentation – Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup> @ St. Agnes at 3:00PM. People can start coming in at 2:00PM. On the conference website there is a form that you need to download and submit with the athlete's names typed (send to Jose Velazquez AND Frank Ramos). It is an honors Mass. It does not have to be the best athlete to represent your school. For every sport a nominee is, they will receive a medal at the mass. They MUST be present to receive their medallion. You can bring your school banner or flag; remember to bring the base if it is a flag. If it is a banner, they can roll it up and keep it at their seats. Please mark the date. Frank will be sending out a dress code (dress appropriately – no jeans).
9. Roster for playoffs-up to date – Make sure they are up-to-date. Remember you can make up to two changes in the season. If you are bringing an updated Roster, it needs to have your Principal's or Assistant Principal's signature.
10. Fines and Fees – Some of you that have registered for a sport after the fact, the fee requirement needs to be turned in to Frank. Fines will be going out after Val reviews.
11. Share the Wealth P.E. Conference – Gilbert (St. Agnes) recommended to the ADs to attend next year. It was enlightening and really gave great ideas to implement in the P.E. classes. Go to the website and the resources for all of the activities from the conference are posted there. As long as the ACC is can afford to sponsor (hotel, conference, 1 mileage, 1 meal), they will continue to do so. Archdiocese will be distributing a curriculum guide for P.E. for next year.
12. Play Like a Champion – Val is having them shipped directly to the schools unless otherwise notified. If on the day of your event you do not have your books by noon, please let Val know. Frank keeps extras, so we might be able to cover you. We will not be doing another coaches training this year unless Val is notified otherwise. When you have the parent training, a week before the event, give Val a headcount. Make sure you have enough pens or pencils available. Hopefully by the May meeting, Val will be able to tell us how PLACT will be enforced. We will not be taking a group to PLACT at Notre Dame this summer.
13. New Business/Old Business – If you buy P.E. equipment over the summer, don't. Wait until August. Diane (Our Lady of Lourdes) asked if these meetings can get put on RegisterMe for points. Val is going to scan all of the attendance forms and send to Marcy at the Archdiocese. It will only count for certified Physical Education Teachers.
