## **NEWS AND NOTES**

### **PRESIDENT'S NOTE**

Hello One Island Family!

It's almost June already! Our last month of services before our seasonal break. Time really does seem to fly. June is Pride month here in town and we are pleased to have two Pride-related services. The first one is on June 2<sup>nd</sup> where we will have our good friends from Queer Keys joining us to help kick off Key West Pride week. Then on June 9<sup>th</sup>, on the closing day of Pride Week, our Affiliate Minister Rev. Doug Slagle will help



us to explore being our authentic selves. This is a very special Pride month for One Island Family as we celebrate for the first time being an officially designated UUA Welcoming Congregation! As I announced in last month's newsletter, we are very excited to have officially earned that designation from the Unitarian Universalist Association.

In other news, at the Annual Meeting in January, I mentioned that we had some significant repair work that needed to be done on the exterior wall of our building. We also found significant spalling (concrete issues) in the apartment that need to be corrected as well as kitchen cabinets that were deteriorating badly in the apartment. Over the course of the last 6 months the board has been getting multiple bids and reviewing the scope of the proposed work in order to maintain the safety and integrity of the building(s) at the lowest possible costs. I have summarized the projects and their statuses below. If you would like additional information on any of these projects, please contact me, Dave Arnold or Joy Taylor.

Apartment Kitchen – The old cabinets, counters and backsplash have been replaced. Most of the replacements were made using materials donated from a remodeling job at another client location which kept costs down substantially. We are investigating whether it will be possible to replace the kitchen floor before completion. It is currently a patchwork of 3 different linoleum tiles in a space of about 10 feet.

Apartment Spalling – We are waiting for a 2<sup>nd</sup> final estimate including the plumbing work to move exterior piping.

Exterior Wall – The initial estimate anticipated having to repair the entire wall. We have a 2<sup>nd</sup> estimate at a lower cost which only requires repairing a portion of the wall. This approach will save a significant amount of money if the demolition does not uncover issues that require the entire wall repair as anticipated in the 1<sup>st</sup> estimate.

All the repairs will be paid for from the One Island Family cash reserves.

I hope to see you at the Memorial Day picnic/potluck on Sunday and at our June Pride services!
