Approval Process	<p>Grant Review Committee will review the applications and ensure the finalists are picked in a manner to support all three townships fairly.</p> <p>Decisions will be informed to the grant applicants before the project start date.</p>
Duration	<p>Project periods: Projects should start between August 08<sup>th</sup> and should be completed before September 30<sup>th</sup> 2022 (can be a single day project or run throughout the period).</p>

### Grant Guides for Review Team

- Ensure the fairness of distribution of Grant money by guaranteeing each of the 3 partnering townships are served with a main grant recipient (\$800 each).
  - In the case of no applications from a township, committee is requested to find the next best application from the other two townships, where the impact of the project will benefit the region.
- 2 junior grants to be awarded for \$300 each. Junior grant recipient to be picked on the basis
  - Creativity and innovativeness
  - Project that has the most impact
- Ensure each project meet the highlighted guidelines
