The objective of the required 6 to 8 months is that these items stated can be achieved through Phasing, three phases have been discussed:

Phase 1- Ceiling venting, walls of nave treated, and the sanctuary completed.

Phase 2- Paintings/pattern on upper clerestory, murals and the side vaults with stencils.


Phase 3-Ceiling restored, decorated and balcony high wall finished.

ESTIMATED BUDGET:

Phase 1- \$142,500 Phase 2- \$135,840 Phase 3- \$85,500 Scaffolding- \$26,400

Lighting- \$48,600 New Item

Accommodations-\$ 1,400 monthly, estimated 6-8 months total
