

## Contest Application Instructions

- There will be an informational meeting on Wednesday, June 1. Since there will be additional information you will need for the contest, this meeting is mandatory unless prior arrangements are made with the Queen Coordinator. The meeting will be at 6 p.m., at the picnic shelter by Cy Young Pool rain or shine.
- All contestants' musts reside in Tuscarawas, Guernsey, or Coshocton County.
- All contestants must submit a head shot, a bio page, and a \$10 non-refundable entry fee to the Queen Coordinator, Jennifer Lindig, by Wednesday, June 1. Entries can also be mailed prior to June 1 if you wish. The address is: Jennifer Lindig, 234 N 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Coshocton, OH 43812. - The Queen/Junior Queen contestants will need to write a one-page paper on "Why I want to be Queen or Junior Queen." You will need to have two copies so that you have one for yourself to practice; you will be reading your paper at the Queen's Tea Thursday, June 16, at 6 p.m. The contestants will be judged on their paper and participation in the tea, their stage presence, their festival "pitch", their personal interview, and a question from the bag.
- The Princess will be judged on stage presence, a short 50-word essay on "Why I want to be Princess," an on-stage interview, and a question from the bag.
- The Little Miss and Little Slugger will be judged on stage presence and their ability to say their name, age, and what they want to be when they grow up.
