West Haven City is currently extending 4700 West between 4600 South and 4800 South, with a planned completion date of July 2016. The project includes intersection improvements at the 4800 South intersection. To plan for future traffic demands, Hooper City has secured funding to continue improvements southward to 5500 South, including the piping of irrigation ditches and addition of roadway shoulders, storm drain, curb, gutter and sidewalk. Planned improvements will provide for a uniform 4700 South roadway corridor and improve safety and drainage.

The project is primarily funded through the Wasatch Front Regional Council and Weber County. Most of the improvements are expected to fit within the existing 66-foot public right-of-way. Prior to construction, the City will complete an environmental study which will evaluate impacts to private property.

Once impacts have been identified, the project team will schedule individual meetings with homeowners to present the proposed design and address any concerns. Construction is expected to begin by spring 2017 and will be phased as funding allows.

NEXT STEPS

Prior to construction, project funding requires an environmental study under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The study is underway and includes an evaluation of biological resources (wetland, wildlife, farmland), a cultural survey and an evaluation of public open space including historic and recreational properties.
