Guys, Gals, please come out to join us for this year's Tour of South Jersey. This year's Tour will be a bit DIFFERENT than we have done in year's past. NEW for this year, the starting location has changed. The starting location for the Tour will now be changing every year so that we can cover a larger area of South Jersey and explore new areas we haven't done before. For 2018, the starting location will be:

THE HARRISON HOUSE DINER. Located at the intersection of Rt. 322 and Rt. 45 in MULLICA HILL.

We will then proceed along a route of scenic back roads, lots of twists and turns for your driving pleasure, into the town of Pennsville winding along the Delaware River until we reach our rest stop at FT. MOTT STATE PARK. At Ft. Mott, we will have the ability to rest our cars, and our butts, use the facilities, and tour the historic COASTAL DEFENSE BATTERY, before continuing the Tour.

Upon leaving Ft. Mott, we will drive past historic FINNS POINT LIGHTHOUSE and through the SUPAWNA MEADOWS WILDLIFE REFUGE en route to our final destination of HUDOCK'S CUSTARD STAND in Quinton Twp.

HUDOCK'S CUSTARD STAND is located directly on the old shore route of Rt. 49 between Salem City and Bridgeton. With its famous two white buildings with the yellow roofs, Hudock's Custard Stand has been an icon since the 1950's serving up some of South Jersey's finest ice cream (made on premises), as well as the food building famous for it's foot long hot dogs and "The Bellybuster" burger. Please be advised that Hudock's is a CASH ONLY business, so if you wish to partake, please bring cash with you.

For those coming from Camden, Burlington, or Gloucester Counties that may not be familiar with the area, if you follow me, I can lead you back into Woodstown, (about 10-15 minute drive), to the intersection of Rt. 40 & Rt. 45, which will get you home from wherever you came from. Those coming from Cumberland County and the Shore area will be able to continue along Rt. 49 to get home.
