Dear Parents/Guardians:

This week is our last week of school and it is a very busy week. This letter is just a reminder of the upcoming events for the rest of the school year.

Tuition Contracts and Tuition Assistance

If you have not already completed and returned your 2018-2019 Tuition Contract and Tuition Assistance forms; please do so **As Soon As Possible.** These forms serve as your letter of intent for the 2018-2019 school year. These forms also give us an idea of how many students will be in each grade next year, so we can properly order supplies. The \$50.00 per student Registration and Materials Fee is due by **Friday, May 18th (last day of school).**

I will be reviewing all of our Tuition Assistance applications in early June. Please return this form, along with a copy of your 2017 Tax Return, if you would like to be considered for any additional tuition assistance. The amount of aid that we give out is based on our current funds available and number of families applying.

Used School Uniform Collection

We will begin collecting gently used school uniforms STARTING MONDAY, MAY 14th and running through FRIDAY, JUNE 8th. If you have any school uniforms that your child(ren) can no longer use, please drop them off at the School Office. For those of you interested in buying gently used school uniforms for next year, we will begin selling them for \$1.00 a piece starting Monday, August 6th and running through Friday, August 24th. We do ask that all uniforms be washed before turning into the school.
