in 1973 and also represented NDWA's predecessor organizations. My father Donald Kienlen, former Principal of Murray, Burns and Kienlen, participated extensively in the negotiations of the Contract between the State of California, Department of Water Resources and North Delta Water Agency for the Assurance of a Dependable Water Supply of Suitable Quality ("1981 Contract") (Exhibit DWR-306). Since the commencement of my employment with MBK Engineers in 1988, I have been involved with monitoring water quality, contract compliance, and related issues for NDWA. Since 1999, I have served as engineer for NDWA.

- 4. I have reviewed the testimony submitted by Petitioners in support of the case-inchief in this proceeding, together with the supporting exhibits. I have also reviewed the testimony of my colleague, Gomathishankar Parvathinathan, and concur in that testimony.
