Voting on our efforts to date and their expansion, produced phenomenal positive approval margins of 87%, 91% & 99%.

We are both honored and humbled!

Apparently, you like what you see. The Dolphin Fountain Renewal on SR19 is all but completed. There's a bit of tweaking and energy cost cutting still going on, but the project is basically done.

Greatly improved appearance, weed & moisture control, as well as substantially reduced maintenance costs and work, have been achieved, and for under \$900. These improvements will also quickly pay for themselves. Nothing says Success better than Results!

Now the fun part, watching the Dolphin Fountain magically, become more beautiful with each passing day.

Next ... Tackling The Triangle! The TTT plan is to accomplish very similar cost cutting improvement there, as we did at the Dolphin Fountain. We have already begun this project, by getting the weeds and cattails under control, removing dead plants and interfering, out of control shrubs and trees where required. Some plants were moved. Some new plantings have already been installed. Again we are trying o keep it simple and relatively maintenance free. This project is 3-4. times the size of the fountain project.

Therefore, it will take that much more materials, work, time and effort.

Unfortunately, yet another vehicle slammed into the Triangle landscaping going South, similar to the last accident, and again at about 2AM. The implications are obvious. It couldn't have helped that the county parked a safety sign, facing the other way, blocking the view of the yellow flashing warning light from a distance. This time though, they couldn't drive off and the police were involved. Hopefully, they had insurance and we can recover the rather extensive damages. As of the time of this writing, committee member Kathy Watkins, is still waiting for the accident report, and the damage repair estimates.


