Cacapon Resort State Park is the ideal site for nature seekers or those wanting a challenge [golfing](#). The sprawling 18-hole, Par 72 championship golf course designed by golf course Robert Trent Jones Sr., makes prime use of the rolling foothills at the base of the ridge. Rated as one of the 130 best-designed courses in the United States, the Cacapon course features 73 well-placed sand bunkers. There are three ponds on the course which come into play on four holes. The course has several other water hazards in the form of small streams coming from the mountain side. The course is known for a double green that is over 100 yards wide.

The resort has 6,000 acres of exciting outdoor getaways any time of year. Cacapon provides, [lake activities](#), [hiking opportunities](#), and restaurant. Other activities include picnicking and swimming along the beach at Cacapon Resort State Park Lake, twenty miles scenic hiking trails, picnic areas, playground, clay trap shooting range, horseback riding, tennis courts, basketball, volleyball and fishing.
