Rules & Regulations 2017

\$7500 Added Open 1D FUTURITY

- 1. The Futurity is open to any horse that is a foal of 2012 or younger. Horse must not reach the age of 6 during the 2017 year. Entries may be mouthed by a licensed veterinarian at the time of check in. The veterinarian's decision is final.
- 2. To enter the futurity the horse must not have competed in a barrel race prior to December 1, 2016. This excludes time only or exhibition runs. Failure to comply with this rule means forfeiture of entry fees paid and elimination from Futurity.
- 3. Name of the horse must be specified at the time of entry. If the horse is registered, a front and back copy of the registration papers must be submitted with the nomination payment. If the horse is unregistered, a veterinarian affidavit of year of birth and owners signature must accompany nomination payment. If you are not the owner listed on the papers, the OWNER must sign. All money won will be paid to the registered owner of the horse unless written permission from the owner is received in advance. Owner's social security number must be on the nomination form.
- 4. Futurity horses may only compete one (1) year, either 3, 4 or 5 years of age. No cross entry with the Derby Maturity.
- 5. The Futurity entry fee per horse is \$300.

Absolutely no refunds. There will be a \$35 service charge on all returned checks.

- 6. Futurity will be paid out in the 1D format with a 2D side-pot w/ a full second split (no extra EF). 70% EF for all fully paid horses goes to Futurity payout. All late, drop out and substitution fees will be retained by the committee. Two go rounds and an average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average. Futurity champion will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the week-end will determine the champion.
- 7. First payment made is considered the nomination. Nominations postmarked after March 1, 2017 will be assessed a \$50 late fee PER LATE PAYMENT. Once nomination is made, any sustaining payments postmarked after the dates listed above will also be assessed a late fee of \$50 PER LATE PAYMENT. All entries must be postmarked on or before they are due, regardless of a Sunday or a Holiday. Any entry postmarked later than May 1st will be in the late draw and assessed LATE FEES (\$150). No entries will be taken after 5pm on Monday, May 22, 2017. No exceptions.
- 8. Substitutions allowed: Substitution of horses due to injury, illness, death, or sale of nominated horse with a veterinarian's affidavit will be allowed with a fee of \$75 by 5pm Monday May 22, 2017. Substitution horse must meet eligibility requirements. Substitution of rider due to injury, illness, death, or sale of nominated horse will be allowed with a \$75 fee by 5pm on Monday May 22, 2017.
- 9. Buyouts allowed: Buyout of Futurity spot will be allowed with a \$75 fee and must be made by 5pm on Monday, May 22, 2017.
- 10. A knocked down barrel will result in a 5 second penalty.

- 11. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a re-run and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked by the tractor every 5 runs and a big drag(s) will be determined by the total entries.
- 12. Futurity runs will have the option to carry over to the Open 5D & Fast Cash Slot Race. No options to cross enter in the Derby.
- 13. Wyoming All Breed Racing Association is offering a \$1000 Wyoming Bred Incentive to be paid out over 2 rounds. This will be paid by the organization. Eligible offspring must meet requirements as per Wyoming All Breed Association enrollment rules. For additional information, please see their website wabra.org.
- 14. ***Future Fortunes has added \$10,000 to the Open in a 4D format with ½ second splits. Your horse must be eligible and nominated with the Future Fortunes program. You can visit their website at futurefortunesinc.com. All futurity/derby horses have the option to carry over the time from their event to the Open 5D races and through this carry over option are then eligible for the Future Fortunes Open Bonus Money. The Future Fortunes program is a self-reporting program. It is the responsibility of the owner to indicate the horse is Future Fortune eligible and provide substantiating evidence. ALL Future Fortune eligible horses must submit a copy of the horse's papers showing current owner with entry and this must be marked on the entry form at time of entry.
- 15. Triple Crown 100 (\$1500) bonus money program for eligible horses and their winnings will be paid directly by the respective organization. No extra entry fee.

Cowboy State Stallion Incentive Futurity (1D side pot for eligible progeny)

- 1. The Cowboy State Stallion Incentive Futurity is a side pot open to eligible offspring of currently nominated stallions that are foaled in 2012 or sooner. All futurity rules above apply; this is a side pot for the Futurity so eligible progeny must enter the Futurity in order to enter the CSSI Futurity side pot. Nominated stallions may also enter the Futurity Stallion Incentive if they meet the age requirements.
- 2. Money will payout in a 1D format, based on total eligible entries and money generated from the Cowboy State Stallion Service Auction that is held in January. To view a current list of enrolled stallions please visit www.reddesertfuturity.com. 80% of entry fee will be paid out in two go rounds and an average to eligible progeny.
- 3. Name of the horse must be specified at the time of entry. Horses must be registered and a front and back copy of the registration papers must be submitted with the nomination payment. If you are not the owner listed on the papers, the OWNER must sign. All money won will be paid to the registered owner of the horse unless written permission from the owner is received in advance. Owner's social security number must be on the nomination form.
- 4. The Stallion Incentive Futurity entry fee per horse is \$100.

NEW for 2017! \$2,000 Added Open 1D DERBY MATURITY

- 1. Open to any horse 5 years or older that has previously competed in the Red Desert Futurity or Derby. May not cross enter in the Futurity. Rule Exception: 2017 (1st year of class) we will open it up to any horse that meets the age requirement whether or not they have competed in the RDC Futurity or Derby previously. This will be the only year that rule applies.
- 2. Name of the horse must be specified at the time of entry. If the horse is registered, a front and back copy of the registration papers must be submitted with the nomination payment. If the horse is unregistered, a veterinarian affidavit of year of birth and owners signature must accompany nomination payment. If you are not the owner listed on the papers, the OWNER must sign. All money won will be paid to the registered owner of the horse unless written permission from the owner is received in advance. Owner's social security number must be on the nomination form.
- 3. The Derby Maturity entry fee per horse is \$200.

- 4. Derby Maturity will be paid out in the 1D format and a \$500 added 2D side-pot with a full second split (no extra EF). 70% EF for all fully paid horses goes to Derby payout. All late fees or drop out fees will be retained by the committee. Two go rounds and an average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average. Futurity champion will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the week-end will determine the champion.
- 5. First payment made is considered the nomination. Nominations postmarked after March 1, 2017 will be assessed a \$50 late fee PER LATE PAYMENT. Once nomination is made, any sustaining payments postmarked after the dates listed above will also be assessed a late fee of \$50 PER LATE PAYMENT. All entries must be postmarked on or before they are due, regardless of a Sunday or a Holiday. Any entry postmarked later than May 1st will be in the late draw and assessed LATE FEES (\$150). No entries will be taken after 5pm on Monday, May 22, 2017. No exceptions.
- 6. Substitution of rider due to injury, illness, death, or sale of nominated horse will be allowed with a \$75 fee by 5pm on Monday May 22, 2017.

- 7. Buyouts allowed: Buyout of Derby spot will be allowed with a \$75 fee and must be made by 5pm on Monday, May 22, 2017.
- 8. A knocked down barrel will result in a 5 second penalty.
- 9. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a re-run and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked by the tractor every 5 runs and a big drag(s) will be determined by the total entries.
- 10. Derby Maturity runs will have the option to carry over to the open 5D & Fast Cash Slot Race.
- 11. Wyoming All Breed Racing Association will offer a \$500 incentive to all eligible Wyoming Bred Horses as per the rules of enrollment with WABRA. You can find out additional information about this at WABRA.org.
- 12. ***Future Fortunes has added \$10,000 to the Open in a 4D format with ½ second splits. Your horse must be eligible and nominated with the Future Fortunes program. You can visit their website at futurefortunesinc.com. All futurity/derby horses have the option to carry over the time from their event to the Open 5D races and through this carry over option are then eligible for the Future Fortunes Open Bonus Money. The Future Fortunes program is a self-reporting program. It is the responsibility of the owner to indicate the horse is Future Fortune eligible and provide substantiating evidence. ALL Future Fortune eligible horses must submit a copy of the horse's papers showing current owner with entry.

Cowboy State Stallion Incentive Derby (1D side-pot for eligible progeny)

- 1. The Cowboy State Stallion Incentive Derby is a side pot open to eligible offspring of currently nominated stallions that are 5, 6 or 7 years of age only. Horses must enter the Derby Maturity in order to enter the CSSI Derby side-pot. Nominated stallions may also enter the Derby Stallion Incentive if they meet the age requirements.
- 2. Money will Payout in a 1D format, based on total eligible entries and money generated from the Cowboy State Stallion Service Auction that is held in January. To view a current list of enrolled stallions please visit www.reddesertfuturity.com. 80% of entry fee will be paid out in two go rounds and an average to eligible progeny.
- 3. Name of the horse must be specified at the time of entry. Horses must be registered and a front and back copy of the registration papers must be submitted with the nomination payment. If you are not the owner listed on the papers, the OWNER must sign. All money won will be paid to the registered owner of the horse unless written permission from the owner is received in advance. Owner's social security number must be on the nomination form.
- 4. The Stallion Incentive Derby entry fee per horse is \$75.

- 3. Pre-enter deadline must be post marked by May 22, 2017. Late entries taken each day until 9:00 am, each day with a \$10 late fee per person. All late entries will be in the late draw. CASH ONLY for all late entries.
- 4. Open 5D will be paid out in the 5D format and be a half second split. 70% EF for all fully paid horses goes to Open 5D payout. All late, drop out and substitution fees will be retained by the committee. Two go rounds and an average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average. Open 5D champions will be determined by the average. In case of a tie, the fast time of the week-end will determine the champion.
- 5. A knocked down barrel will result in a no time penalty.
- 6. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a re-run and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked by the tractor every 5 runs and a big drag(s) will be determined by the total entries.
- 7. Draw Outs: 70% of Entry Fee Refunds are available ONLY with a Veterinarian's or Doctor's release and must be received by 9am on the day of the race (Friday or Saturday). Processing Fees (30%) are not refundable.
- 8. Future Fortunes (\$10,000) bonus money for eligible horses and their winnings will be paid directly by the respective organization. Paid only on Saturday. Must specify FF eligible horses on entry form.

Junior Youth 3D

- 1. Open to Riders 16 and Under. Riders can enter multiple horses.
- 2. \$35 entry fee per horse. May be carried over from Open 5D, Futurity or Derby Maturity
- 3. Pre-enter deadline must be post marked by May 22, 2017. Late entries taken each day until 9:00 am with a \$10 late fee per person. All late entries will be in the late draw. CASH ONLY for all late entries.
- 4. Junior Youth will be paid out in the 3D format and be a full second split. 70% EF for all fully paid horses goes to Junior Youth payout. All late, drop out and substitution fees will be retained by the committee.
- 5. A knocked down barrel will result in a no time penalty.
- 6. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a re-run and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked by the tractor every 5 runs and a big drag(s) will be determined by the total entries.
- 7. Draw Outs: 70% of Entry Fee Refunds are available ONLY with a Veterinarian's or Doctor's release and must be received by 9am on the day of the race (Saturday). Processing Fees (30%) are not refundable.

NEW for 2017! Fast Cash Slot Race

- 1. Open to all riders and horses. Riders may enter multiple horses. Entries may carry over from the Futurity or Derby Maturity.
- 2. \$10,000 Payout to 1st Place (with 50 paid entries). Limited to 50 entries. Must have 30 entries by March 1, 2017 to have class.
- 3. Entry fee is \$350 entry fee per horse + \$50 processing fee

- 5. The Fast Cash will be paid out in the 1D format. 100% Payout for all horses fully paid (vet outs/doc releases not included). All late, drop out and substitution fees will be retained by the committee.
- 6. A knocked down barrel will result in a no time penalty.
- 7. An electric timer will be used. If timer fails the contestant will be given the option of a re-run and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked by the tractor every 5 runs and a big drag(s) will be determined by the total entries.

- 1. There are no additional entry fees for the bonus money programs.
- 2. Wyoming All Breed Racing Association is offering a \$1000 in the Futurity & \$500 in the Derby to Wyoming Accredited horses to be paid out over 2 rounds. This will be paid by the organization. Eligible offspring must meet requirements as per Wyoming All Breed Association enrollment rules. All Wyoming Accredited horses must submit a copy of the horse's papers showing proof of WABRA accreditation. For additional information, please see their website wabra.org.
- 3. Triple Crown 100 has added \$1500 to the Futurity. You can learn more about this program by going to triplecrown100.com. Check out their stallion list. New stallions have been added. Any offspring of newly added stallions can be nominated for a low fee of \$200 within the first year of that stallion's enrollment. It is not too late to nominate your horse!
- 4. Future Fortunes has added \$10,000 to the Open in a 4D format with ½ second splits. Your horse must be eligible and nominated with the Future Fortunes program. You can visit their website at futurefortunesinc.com. Please remember that all futurity/derby horses have the option to carry over the time from their event to the open races both days and through this carry over option are then eligible for the Future Fortunes Open Bonus Money. The Future Fortunes program is a self-reporting program. It is the responsibility of the owner to indicate the horse is Future Fortune eligible and provide substantiating evidence. ALL Future Fortune eligible horses must submit a copy of the horse's papers showing current owner with entry.

General Information

- 1. The 2016 Red Desert Classic will be held on June 1-3, 2007 at the Sweetwater Events Center, 3320 Yellowstone Rd, Rock Springs, WY 82901.
- 2. Stall, bedding & RV Hookups are available on site. Please see the Stall/RV Request Form to make your reservations.
- 3. Dress Code: Long sleeve shirts, western pants, hats or helmet, and boots required.
- 8. Electric Timer: Two electric timers will be set up but in the event of malfunction competitors will be given a rerun. If timers fail the contestant will be given the option of a re-run and penalties from the original run will carry over. The ground will be raked by the tractor every 5 runs and a big drag(s) will be determined by the total entries.
- 9. Exhibitions will be sold on a first come, first serve basis for \$5 each. A one (1) minute time limit will be enforced for each one, if you fail to meet the time constraint you will be assessed a fine of \$50 for each instance.
