## ORDINANCE NO. 23-11

# A CITY OF NEWTON ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 38-1-4 ADDING PARAGRAPHS C, D & E TO THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF NEWTON, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Jasper County,

Illinois that Chapter 38-1-4 by adding Paragraphs C, D & E of the City Code of the City of Newton, Illinois, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

### 38-1-4 WASTEWATER TREATMENT RATES.

- (C) <u>Dumping of Typical Domestic Wastewater.</u> Any person who desires to haul typical domestic wastewater in a tank or other vessel and deposit the same into the City's wastewater system shall be entitled to do so by paying a charge of **Four Cents (\$0.04)**\_per gallon based on the size of the applicant's offloading storage tank, but with a minimum charge for such dumping to be **Ten Dollars (\$10.00)**.
- (D) <u>Dumping of Campground or Portable Toilet Wastewater.</u> Any person who desires to haul campground or portable toilet wastewater in a tank or other vessel and deposit the same into the City's wastewater system shall be entitled to do so by paying a charge of <u>Ten Cents (\$0.10)</u> per gallon based on the size of the applicant's offloading storage tank, but with a minimum charge of such dumping to be **Ten Dollars (\$10.00)**.
- (E) Applicable to (C) and (D) only. No person shall deposit any wastewater without an employee designating and providing access to the system and supervising each dumping occurrence. The Superintendent or his representative shall have the right to refuse to accept any wastewater containing chemicals or other items determined by such City employees, in their sole discretion, not to be suitable for processing by the City's wastewater system.

No industrial waste shall be discharged.

No fats, oil or grease shall be discharged.

The City shall not accept more than 10,000 gallons of bulk discharge in a 24-hour period.

All such dumping shall be done during the normal business hours of operation of the City of Newton Wastewater Treatment plant.

The City shall record the total number of tanks dumped and invoice on a monthly basis. All invoices are due upon receipt.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
