Love is a road trip

Summer is a time for road trips, wandering and spending time discovering new places, people and perspectives.

Many years ago, I took a chance to take a very long road trip to Maine including Nutter Butter Cookies, a 1975 Winnebago a very long book and an extensive entourage of family. Myself, my almost toddler daughter and extended family of in-laws and nieces piled



I into the classic mobile home and took off for a road trip to Maine. My daughter traveled with great ease as

co-pilot in car seat next to her Grandfather. She sipped tiny boxes of apple juice, smiled and soaked up sunshine as we wound our way up the east coast. She loved the ride.

Play and escape from my normal fast pace was the focus of this trip. As the trip slowed us down, we cultivated cherished memories of children dancing in crashing ocean waves, rowdy games of "Marco Polo", and looking for 'Winnie the Pooh' in the woods on night time treks to the bathroom. This road trip helped us learn new ways of loving one another over many miles, too few bathrooms, and many beautiful campfires. The love cultivated by our Maine road trip wasn't pretty or cute, it was more like a 1975 Winnebago; patient and persistent with a peculiar way of pulling a motley crew of people together.
