

Dr. Martin Kozachik and Dr. Gerald Brown Scholarship

The Portland Athletic Association would like to honor Dr. Martin Kozachik and Dr. Gerald Brown by offering two (one female and one male) five hundred-dollar (\$500) scholarships to deserving student athletes at Portland High School to be used at a school of their choice.

The positive programs of Portland athletics stress scholarship, leadership, sportsmanship, character, and service. Both, Dr. Kozachik and Dr. Brown, believed strongly in our athletic programs and the student athletes that participated.

Senior student athletes that meet the following criteria may apply for these scholarships. Scholarships can be used for Trade schools along with 2 and 4 - year colleges.

CRITERIA

1. Minimum cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
2. Participation in two varsity sports or two years in a varsity sport and at least one varsity sport during their senior year. (Special consideration may be given for injuries or circumstances deemed unusual.)
3. Involvement in school and/or community sponsored activities including being a part of freshman and JV teams.
4. A five hundred (500) word essay describing how co-curricular activities have enhanced the student's educational experience, i.e. what life skill(s) have been gained through athletic participation, and how those life skills will benefit the student in the future. Life skills are any character building trait (dedication, leadership, time management, etc.) that will help a student athlete their entire life.
5. A wallet sized **photograph** is desired and should be attached to the application.

Applications must be submitted to the Athletic or Main office. All applications and essays should be typed. The applications will be forwarded to the committee formed to review the applications by the Portland Athletic Association.
