This week, we unfortunately had to have two of our classes switch to virtual learning for 2-3 days while a student in each class waits for results of a COVID-19 test. We are strictly following protocols that are part of our Re-Opening Plan, under the direction of Calvert County Health Department. Results of the rapid COVID-19 are not reliable for our regulation, so we must wait for results of standard tests. We understand that this causes an inconvenience for the other students in the classes, but our top priority is the health and safety of our students, families, and staff. We appreciate for your patience and understanding.

Please see the letter from our School Nurse with today's news. We are requesting that any students with allergies and asthma, the symptoms of which are similar to COVID-19, have their healthcare provider provide the school with written documentation of their condition. We hope that this will greatly reduce the need for quarantining and testing due to allergy-related symptoms.
