



Standards of Conduct

1. I, _____, have been read and understand the “Standards of Conduct for All NSCC Personnel.”
2. I will conduct myself in a military manner to bring credit to myself, this Training Contingent, the Naval Sea Cadet Corps, the United States Navy, the Coast Guard and my country.
3. I will not use vulgar, obscene, profane, bullying, humiliating, or racially offensive language. I will not use or tolerate sexist remarks from any cadet or officer. I will not tolerate the harassment of any cadet including myself.
4. I will not threaten, or attempt to do bodily harm to another. I will not take any action that might be considered hostile or threatening to another. I will not tolerate such actions to be made towards myself or any other cadet.
5. I will not instigate, encourage, participate, tolerate or ignore any form of harassment or hazing by any members of the USNSCC, including adult staff or cadets. I will report any instance immediately to the appropriate authority.
6. I will maintain professional relationships with cadets and adult leaders at all times. I will not associate with others in a manner which may be construed as, or lead to, fraternization, indiscretion or favoritism. I will refrain from sexually promiscuous behavior and report any instance immediately to the appropriate authority.
7. I will not take, obtain or withhold, by any means, the property, money, uniform item, or article of value of another. I will not gamble.
8. I will not willfully damage or destroy any U.S. Government, State of Virginia, City of Virginia Beach property, or any property of sponsoring or supporting organizations/companies or personal property of any individual. I will not misuse any property. I will treat others’ property with respect and care.
9. I will maintain the integrity of the unit by reporting violations of Sea Cadet Regulations, and the Standards of Conduct in a timely manner.
10. I understand that alcohol, tobacco, knives, and drugs are strictly forbidden at any Sea Cadet function.
11. I will conduct myself with the highest integrity and will not compromise that integrity by lying, cheating, withholding information, or making false statements, written or verbal.
12. I will pay appropriate courtesies to all officers, instructors, staff cadets, and fellow cadets of the Naval Sea Cadet Corps, as well as all personnel of the Armed Forces.
13. I will give 100 percent effort towards every activity of training. I understand that malingering (faking injury or illness to avoid PT, work, or duties) will not be tolerated and is considered a violation of the Standards of Conduct.
14. I have read and understand these Standards of Conduct, and I agree to hold my shipmates and myself accountable for these Standards of Conduct.
