

TRIAD is ...

S.A.L.T. (Seniors And Law Enforcement Together) Councils, which plan, carry out, and attend TRIAD COUNTY activities.

- Do not pay taxes or handling fees on a "free prize".

- CARRY A 9-1-1 CELL PHONE ON YOU
- Use a gel ink pen on personal checks
