## The Midwest USA "Terrific 12" Game Tournament Rules

Overview: This is a USBC-certified youth scratch bowling tournament. The tournament will be held on Saturday, June 25, 2016 at Pla-Mor Lanes 4901 Linden Ave., Dayton, Ohio 45432. 937.253.3111. Doors open and check-in begins at 9:00 AM. Warm-ups at 9:45 AM. Tournament play begins about 10:00 AM Eastern time. There are two separate divisions. A boys division and a girls division. Entries are limited to 66 paid bowlers, regardless of division on a first come-first served basis. No E-mails/phone calls to reserve an entry without payment will be accepted. USBC Jr. Gold membership is not required to bowl in this tournament.
Format: The format for this tournament is the same for both divisions. Qualifying Round: All bowlers will bowl twelve (12) games. Championship Round: The top 8 bowlers from the Qualifying Round will advance to bowl a single game head-to-head bracketed Championship Round until a Champion is determined. Ties for advancement to the Championship Round top 8 and bracket placement will be broken by the high game rolled in the Qualifying Round. Ties in the Championship Round will be broken by a 9th/10th roll-off.
Lane Conditions: We will apply 3 different WTBA sport patterns (used in past Jr. Gold National Championships) to our Armor Plate 3000 synthetic lanes. Lanes 1-8 will be a short oil pattern. Lanes $9-16$ will be a medium oil pattern. Lanes $17-24$ will be a long oil pattern. All bowlers will move one pair of lanes to the right after each game allowing all bowlers to experience all 3 lane conditions acknowledging that no bowler will bowl an equal number of games on each sport pattern. The lane patterns will be on display in the tournament office.
Cost: The pre-paid (received on or before Friday, 6.24.16) entry fee is $\$ 80.00$ per bowler. Breakdown for pre-paid entries: Cost of bowling: $\$ 32.00$. Tournament expenses: $\$ 8.00$. SMART scholarships for youth bowlers: $\$ 40.00$. Total pre-paid entry fee: $\$ 80.00$. Walk-in (after 5:00 PM, Friday, 6.26.15) entries (accepted depending on lane availability) will be assessed an additional $\$ 10.00$ late processing fee. Only paid-in-full entries will be accepted. The closing date for paid entries is prior to the start of bowling on Saturday, June 25, 2016.
General Rules: A collared shirt or a non-collared shirt made of "dri-mesh" fabric is required. No jeans, hats, or non-medical headgear. Shorts/skirts may be worn provided they pass the "fingertip-length" test. Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language, gestures, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at this tournament. Tardy bowlers will receive a zero (0) score for all frames missed. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or any foreign substance on shoes, the approach, or on the facility floor or carpet is not permitted. The surface of any bowling ball may not be altered after competition begins. Competition begins when scoring begins (game 1). The surface may not be altered during any break. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowling area. The Tournament Manager has the right to refuse any entry. The bowler, by voluntary participation in the event, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Manager to interpret and enforce all rules, regulations, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation(s) will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretative judgment guided by the best interest of youth bowling and this event. USBC Rule 400 will be observed.
Awards: The first (1st) place bowler in each division will be awarded no less than a $\$ 500.00$ SMART scholarship. No fewer than one (1) of six (6) bowlers entered in each division will be awarded a SMART scholarship. The number of SMART scholarships awarded in each division will be based on the number of paid entries in each division. $100 \%$ of all collected scholarship funds will be awarded and sent to the SMART Program for management and dispersal (Acct. \# 8871)
