First Reading

They were filled with the Holy Spirit and stood to speak.

Reading of the Acts of the Postles (2, 1 - 11)

When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all gathered together in one place. Suddenly it came from there was a noise, like a violent gust of wind, that filled the whole house where they were and they began to speak different languages, in which the spirit allowed them to express themselves. They appeared tongues like fire, which, separating, they were posing on each of them and were filled with the Holy Spirit. In Jerusalem there were Jews and God-fearing men from all the nations of the earth. When this noise occurred, the people met and were amazed to hear the apostles speak in their own language. Amazed and admired, they said: Are not all of these Galileans talking? So, each of us hear them talking in our own language?; among us there are Parthians, Medes and Elamites, inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea, Cappadocia and Pontus There are men from Asia, Phrygia, Pamphylia, and Egypt and from the part of Libya that borders Cyrene; there are foreigners, Romans, Jews and men Jews who accepted their beliefs; Cretans and Arabs; and yet, we all hear them speak in our language the wonders of the Lord."

Second Reading

Reading of the first letter of the Apostle Saint Paul Corinthians (12, 3b - 7, 12 13)
