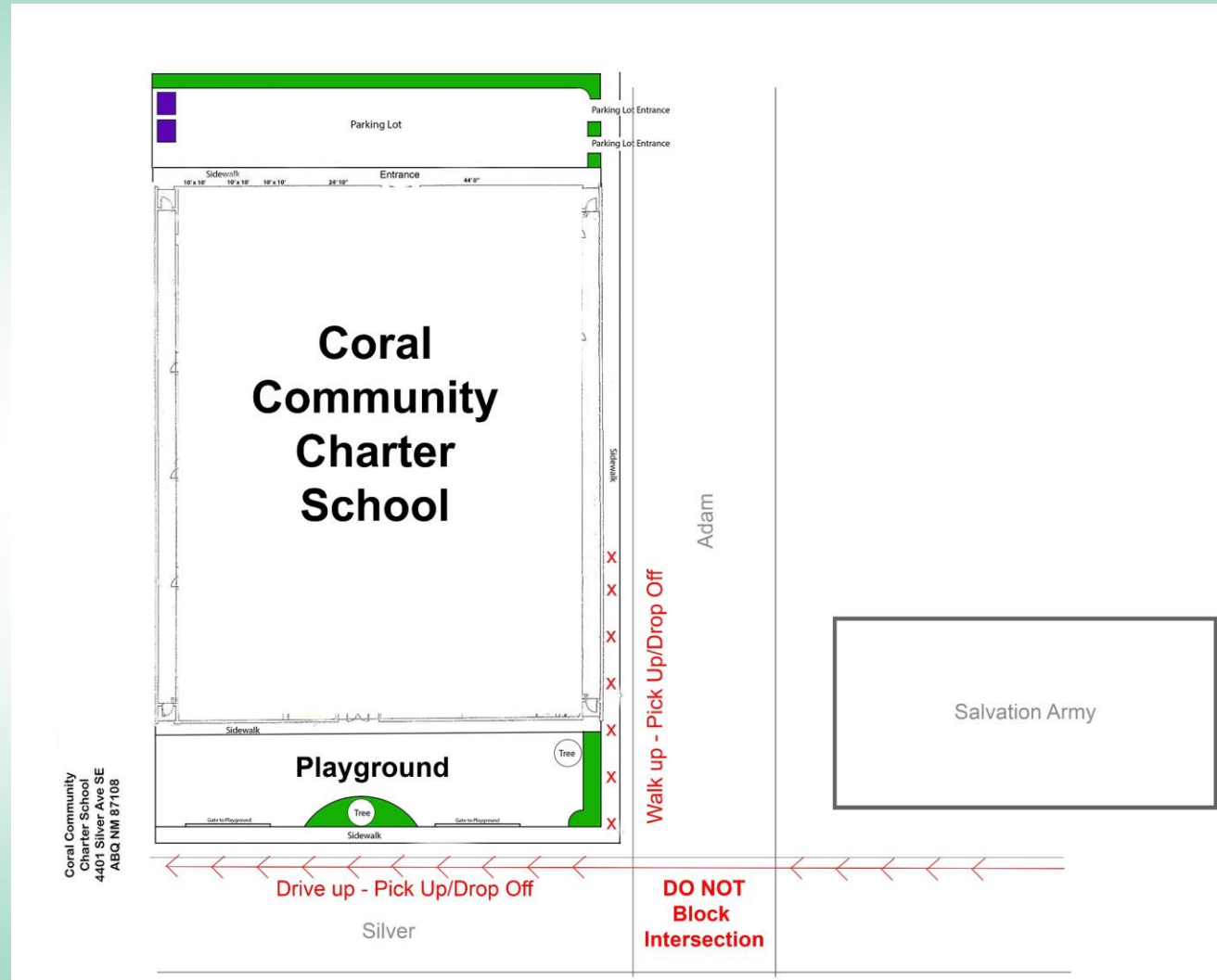
Procedures

- Therapies

- Virtual Community Gatherings on Wednesdays
- Art & PE

- Wednesday live lab times
- Concurrent teaching & learning
- More Promethean, Less Screen
- No Weekly Check Ins
- In person community gatherings on scheduled days for each class – check daily schedules

Additional Safety Measures

- HVAC – Merv 13 filters & open dampers
- Daily, teachers will educate, model, reinforce COVID safe practices
- Classroom arrangement & removal of furniture
- For K to 5th, student desks with space for all personal items
- For PreK, individual student cubbies
- Individual student supply packets that stay at desks and are not shared
- Plexiglass barriers
- Sanitation stations
- Clearly defined procedures for transitions
- All staff training
