# A. December Water Loss Report

The latest coliform test for the new well is acceptable. The remaining work to hook into the system should be done within the next 10 days.

These three accounts were charged a \$50.00 shut-off fee during disconnect. These properties were already turned off. The accounts were updated to reflect the meter being off and the \$50.00 fee was removed from the accounts.
