# NEW PARK CONSTRUCTION BEGINS AT THE GARDENS

If you've been by the Botanical Gardens lately, you may have noticed a lot of construction activity going on at the entrance. The city has begun construction on the initial infrastructure and roadways for our city's newest park, unofficially named Westmoreland Park.

A waterfront restaurant will be a key feature of the new park next to our beautiful Botanical Gardens which will include a 2,000-foot addition to the Riverwalk Boardwalk that will connect to the existing section at Veterans Memorial Park in the future. The city is currently seeking a partner to construct as well as operate a waterfront restaurant overlooking the North Fork of the St. Lucie River.

Construction officially began last month on the entrance at Westmoreland Boulevard. The park will include the 1917 Peacock House & 1952 Peacock Lodge, being

August in South Florida!



# **Riverwalk Boardwalk Extension Project**

#### PHASE 1 - FY 17/18

#### For Fiscal Year 2017-18, project construction will include:

» Relocation of two historic structures from Western Port St. Lucie to the 9.75 acre Westmoreland tract that is immediately south of Port St. Lucie Botanical Gardens.

» Entryway improvements to provide access to the park, the botanical gardens, the future historic village, and future boardwalk.

#### PHASE 2 - FY 18/19

#### Fiscal Year 2018-19 construction will include:

» Construction of the southern extension of Riverwalk Boardwalk to just south of PSL Blvd. with connection to Bridge Plaza.

#### **FUTURE PHASES**

#### Future phases will add:

- » Daytime only boat docking slips.
- » A boardwalk connection under Port St. Lucie Boulevard to connect the north and south spans of boardwalk.
- » Additional park improvements to enhance public access to the river.

#### **RESTAURANT OPPORTUNITY**

» Land lease available for a waterfront restaurant.

## What to Plant

Annuals/Bedding plants: The hottest days of summer limit planting to heat-tolerant vinca, coleus, salvia, and celosia. See Annuals: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic\_annual\_landscape\_plants</u>

**Bulbs**: Aztec Iily, butterfly Iily, walking iris, and spider Iily can be planted any time of the year, even late summer. **See** *Bulbs for Florida*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic\_bulbous\_flowers</u>

**Herbs**: Herbs that can be planted from plants (not seeds) include bay laurel, ginger, Mexican tarragon, and rosemary. **See** *Herbs*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic\_herbs</u>

**Vegetables**: Start planting eggplant, okra, peppers, pumpkin, squashes, and tomatoes for the fall garden. **See** *Vegetable Gardening in Florida*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/</u> topic vegetable gardening

## What to Do

**Palms**: Check older fronds for yellowing as it may indicate a magnesium or potassium deficiency. Apply an appropriate palm fertilizer. **See***Palm Nutrition and Fertilization*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic\_palm\_nutrition</u>


**Vegetables**: Solarize the vegetable garden for 4–6 weeks in preparation for fall planting if not done in July. **See** *Soil Solarization*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic\_soil\_solarization</u>

**Poinsettias**: Pinch back poinsettias and mums before the end of the month to allow time for buds to form for winter bloom. **See** *Poinsettias*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic\_poinsettia</u>

**Ornamental plants**: Fertilize those plants that show signs of deficiencies. Rapid growth and leaching rains may result in nutrient deficiencies in some plants. **See** *Nutrient Deficiencies (Landscape Plants)*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/</u> topic nutrient deficiencies landscape plants and Landscape Fertilization: <u>http://</u> edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic landscape fertilization

**Fertilizer Bans**: Numerous municipalities in south Florida prohibit the application of fertilizer to lawns and/or landscape plants during the summer rainy season (June–September). See if such an ordinance exists in your area.

**Annuals/Bedding plants**: Remove spent blooms, cut back, and fertilize flowering annuals and perennials to extend the bloom season into the fall months. **See** *Annuals*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic\_annual\_landscape\_plants</u> and *Perennial Landscape Plants*: <u>http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic\_perennials</u>
