How do you feel when you're talking with someone much smarter than you?

I recently had breakfast with two men who are way smarter than I am. So I just tried to sit there and be quiet. I sat there silently (partly) because I was afraid I might embarrass myself by speaking, but mainly because I wanted to learn something that was valuable. I couldn't learn anything from these two men if I did all the talking!

I think this attitude is what Solomon described when he said, "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge." (<u>Prov 1:7</u>) Fear is another word for respect.
