The Archives serves researchers on a walk-in basis, by appointment or via email. For preliminary information about what the Archival collections contain, the computerized database is available at the Museum (Saturdays 11-3).

Researchers are encouraged to contact us ahead via email, which gives us time to assess what we have prior to arrival or to work on a request in off hours. Please tell us clearly what you are looking for and what you have already learned or found so we don't waste time duplicating your effort.
