#### GOOD RIDDANCE IRMA

#### **Greetings Gardens of Gulf Cove Members;**

Fortunately, Gardens of Gulf Cove was spared the worst of Irma on its destructive path through the southeast United States. Gardens of Gulf Cove suffered very little damage. I know this was a long two weeks for owners, the board and staff.

Gardens of Gulf Cove is in evacuation zone B and was under a mandatory evacuation. For those of you that participated in the largest evacuation in history, you made a wise choice.

To my knowledge the power has been restored to all the homes. The water level mark on Bennett Drive near the weir indicates the water was quite high, I haven't heard of any water entry into homes.

Both pools are open, both parking lots were sealed and re-striped to take advantage of the lull in use.

Staff continues to cut up debris on the common areas. Unlike the homes, we have to private contract to pick up the debris. Please be patient if a debris pile is on a lot near you.

Most people have moved the debris from their yards to the curb for the claw trucks to pick up. The claw truck contractors are coming, we just can't tell you when. They've been seen in the area however.

If you are not here and trees are down in your yard we will let you know shortly. We also realize some people have not returned from evacuating.

If you want me to check the outside of your property for damage or trees, let me know by return email.

If you need trees cut up, you can contact Cuquin at 941-623-5489 or Evans Lawn Care 941-716-3300. Special thanks to Board Member Sandy Weaver for helping get the generators placed at the lift stations. These were critical to keep the sewage pumping to the treatment plants and not backing up in homes.

Had the worst happened, the staff did an outstanding job preparing the property for the storm. It was done timely and effectively. Last year we installed accordion shutters on all the openings at both buildings. In addition, both buildings were inspected for strapping of the roof and attachment to the ground. All were adequately strapped.

Board President Tom Sullivan has called a board meeting for October 12, 2017 at 5:30PM in the clubhouse. The main agenda item will be a critique of the storm preparedness, the aftermath and the clean

up. The purpose to improve the process to make the property as safe and accessible as possible for all future events. If you have any input to improve the situation please submit it and I will present it to the board if you cannot make the meeting.

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

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


