It appeared that the Tennessee-Florida game was headed for overtime but Gator QB Feleipe Franks had different ideas. With 9 seconds on the clock, Franks scrambled to his right to buy some time and unleashed a high arching pass towards the endzone where Florida WR Tyrie Cleveland caught it in stride for a dramatic 26-20 Florida victory as time expired. As we all know, the state of Florida has gone through so much as Hurrican Irma devastated a good portion of the state. So after the Gators were dominated by Michigan to open the season, they saw their 2nd game vs Northern Colorado canceled. They were still reeling from the loss, the storm and player suspensions as well, but they found a way to come through for a huge win. Now they have to travel to Lexington to face a confident Kentucky squad.

Also this past Saturday we saw USC survive Texas in double overtime 27-24 in a great college football game. Once again we applaud Texas and USC for having the guts to schedule each other in the non-conference portion of their schedules.

In the past two weeks no school has proven more than Clemson. They beat Auburn in a very physical game at home and then this past weekend, they traveled to Louisville and dominated the high octane Cardinals 47-21. Dabo Sweeney has a team that is very capable of winning a second consecutive national championship if they can stay healthy. Defensively, Clemson takes a backseat to nobody. They are solid at all 11 positions.

Washington's Dante Pettis now has 8 punt returns for TD's in his career (ties the FBS record with Wes Welker/Texas Tech and Antonio Perkins/Oklahoma)

J.T. Barrett (2 pass TD, 1 rush TD vs Army last Saturday) has been responsible for 107 TD's in his career, breaking Drew Brees' Big Ten record.

Since the start of last season, Tennessee has played an FBS-high 3 OT games (2-1 record) and had 2 games that ended with a TD on the final play (1-1).

Tennessee at Florida, last 2 meetings: In 2015: Tennessee lost, 28-27 on 63-yard gamewinning TD pass. In 2017: Tennessee lost, 26-20 on 63-yard game-winning TD pass.

Alex Hornibrook is the first Wisconsin QB with 4 passing TD's in a game since Russell Wilson did it back in 2011.

Nebraska is 1-2 for the second time in three seasons under Mike Riley. In their previous 54 seasons, Cornhuskers started 1-2 just once (1981).

After beating #25 UCLA, Memphis has picked up a win against an AP-ranked opponent for the the 3rd straight season (beat #18 Houston in 2016 and #13 Ole Miss in 2015).

Kansas lost its 42nd straight road game last Saturday at Ohio, the longest streak by any major college team in the AP Poll era. Below are the 5 longest streaks:

Clemson has 7 straight wins vs AP-ranked teams, longest streak in school history.

# **TCU**



TCU (3-0) travels to Stillwater to take on Oklahoma State (3-0) in a huge battle in the Big 12. It will be televised on ESPN at 3:30 PM EDT.

The big question in this game is can TCU slow down Mason Rudolph and this high flying Cowboy offense? Mike Gundy has done a fabulous job molding this team and OSU has the deepest core of wide receivers in the country so you really can't pick one guy to double cover because they'll burn you by throwing to someone else. We saw how good this TCU defense was when they beat Arkansas, but the Razorbacks didn't have the offensive weapons that Oklahoma State has. That being said, TCU has some pretty good offensive stars too so they should be able to have some success putting points on the board but they are not as explosive as the Cowboys.

Oklahoma State leads the all-time series with TCU, 15-10-2. In Stillwater OSU also leads 9-3-0. Last year Oklahoma State dominated the game 31-6. Mike Gundy and Gary Patterson has faced each other 5 times in this series with Gundy holding a commanding 4-1 advantage. While we were very impressed with TCU's 28-7 win at Arkansas, we're just as impressed with Oklahoma State's 59-21 win at Pitt this past Saturday. With all of that being said, we just flat out believe in this Oklahoma State squad and we're picking the Cowboys to come away with a 38-20 win.



# MOST RECENT RULES CHANGES

2009—Roughing the Kicker. The rules now say that if the punter carries the ball outside the tackle box, he loses protections provided as a kicker. Game Administration. The committee approved a request to allow teams, when approved by conference office and agreed to by both teams, to wear colored jerseys as long as they are clearly contrasting in color. When agreement is unable to be reached, the visiting team shall wear white.

**2010**—Illegal Wedge Formation. On a free-kick down, the rules now make it illegal for three or more members of the receiving team to intention-ally form a wedge (defined as two or more players aligned shoulder to shoulder within two yards of each other) for the purpose of blocking for the ball carrier.

2011—10-Second Subtraction From Game Clock. The rules now say if a penalty is committed with the game clock running and less than one minute remaining in either half, the officials may subtract 10 seconds from the game clock at the option of the offended team. Blocking Below the Waist. The rules now prohibit blocking below the waist except under specific circumstances. This rule establishes the principle that blocking below the waist should be a foul except for some limited circumstances where its danger is less.Unsportsmanlike Conduct Fouls. In situations involving taunting and/or unsportsmanlike conduct, the foul swill now be treated as they occur, instead of as dead-ball fouls. Therefore, if the foul occurs when the ball is live (e.g., in the field of play), the foul will be enforced from that position instead of treating all fouls of this type as dead ball fouls (after the play is complete).

2012—Players are no longer allowed to leap over blockers in an attempt to block a punt. After a touchback on a kickoff, the ball will be placed on the 25-yard line instead of the 20.Kickoffs will be moved from the 30-yard line to the 35.Players on kick coverage cannot line up more than five yards off the ball. If a player loses his helmet, he must leave the field for one play unless there was a face mask penalty. Offensive players in the tackle box and not in motion at the snap of the ball can block below the

waist legally without restriction.

2013—In addition to the 15-yard penalty for using the helmet as a weapon and the targeting of defenseless players, there will also be an automatic ejection of the player. If the penalty occurs in the first half, the player must sit out the rest of the game. If the penalty occurs in the second half, the player must sit out the rest of the game plus the first half of the next game. The replay official can overturn the call on the field. Blocking below the waist is now allowed in typical line play within seven yards of the ball along the line of scrimmage. With less than a minute remaining in either half, a 10-second runoff of the game clock is optional if the sole reason for the clock to stop is an injury. Three seconds is the minimum amount of time required to be on the game clock in order to spike the ball to stop the clock. If one or two seconds remain on the clock, there is only time for the offense to run one more play. If a player's helmet comes off during a play, he may remain in the game if his team is granted a charged timeout.

2014—The "targeting" rule enacted for the 2013 season was modified whereby if a targeting ejection is overturned on review, the 15-yard penalty also will be overturned, unless the foul was committed in conjunction with another foul, such as an above-the-shoulders hit on a quarterback not deemed as targeting or a roughing-the-passer penalty. All conferences have the option to implement eight-man officiating crews. The 15-yard "roughing the passer" penalty was modified to include hits (including lunging and/or rolling) at or below the knees from defenders who are not fouled/blocked into the quarterback, not engaged in tackling the quarterback, or are rushing unabated to the quarterback.

**2015**—Blocking by the kicking team's players before they are eligible to touch the ball on an on-side kick is now a reviewable play. After the ball is dead, using forcible contact to push or pull an opponent off the pile is now an unsportsmanlike conduct foul.

2017—Foul added for leaping or hurdling players in attempt to block a kick.
