In the distant past, St. Albertus' pews had nameplates on them. These plates were used to honor people who gave donations to St. Albertus Parish. If you look closely at the pews, you can see where nails held the plates down. The nameplates are long gone now. We feel that plates like those used in the past would be a great way to honor people who donate to the Polish American Historic Site Association (P.A.H.S.A.). P.A.H.S.A. is valiantly trying to maintain the St. Albertus Historic District — your heritage. Maintaining a 131 year old church that seats 2,500 people and a 125 year old rectory is a huge undertaking. The church building is deteriorating and needs to be maintained by professionals. Roof leaks have caused extensive damage to walls and art work. The school building and rectory have also suffered extensive damage. A very small number of volunteers have sacrificed thousands of hours of their own time, their efforts, and their money to maintain and start restoration of St. Albertus Historic District. But P.A.H.S.A. needs much more help.
